


The contract was recently rescoped to shift schedule one work to the Sabine River, with two added options in the Neches River, including the Port of Port Arthur berth slips and an additional option at the junction. This revised scope was developed to avoid operational conflicts with ongoing new work dredging activities and to better align with current priorities and access windows.

Sabine-Neches Waterway – Half/Full Depth Contracts








